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CURRENT PROGRAM ACTIVITIES

Strengthening academic training related to sustainable industrial development (SID) through faculty capacity building for delivering new content, curricular design and modification, and training environmental professionals in partner countries.

Areas of Training in Year 1:

- General Framework for CP
- Diagnostic Tools for CP
- Clean Technology Options
- Business Case for CP
- Industrial Ecology
- Life Cycle Assessment & Ecodesign

The First Faculty Capacity Building Workshops were held at INTEC in the Dominican Republic in December 2012 and at UCA in El Salvador in January 2013. Approximately 30 people participated in each workshop comprised mainly of academic faculty with representatives from industry and government.



Increasing adoption of cleaner production and sustainability practices in micro, small and medium enterprises (MSMEs) through increased interaction with academia, especially through experiential learning projects where students work directly with MSMEs.

The CP Practicum Pilot Courses are being run at INTEC in the Dominican Republic in February-April 2013 and at UCA in El Salvador in March-July 2013. The first practicum courses in the other Latin American host countries will take place later in 2013 and early 2014. In the Dominican Republic the students will work with the furniture industry and those in El Salvador with the food sector.
